Devarim 17: 8 **If there arises a matter too hard for you in mishpat, between dahm and dahm, between plea and plea, and between stroke and stroke, being matters of controversy** within your gates: then shall you arise, and get up into the place which יהוה -YHWH your Elohim shall choose;

9 **And you shall come to the kohanim the Lewiym, and to the shophet that shall be in those days, and inquire; and they shall show you the sentence of mishpat:**

10 **And you shall do according to the sentence, which they of that place [last sitting Sanhedrin in Jerusalem later moved to Galilee] which YHWH shall choose shall show you; and you shall shomer to do according to all that they inform you:**

11 **According to the sentence of the Torah that they shall teach you, and according to the mishpat that they shall tell you, you shall do: you shall not decline from the ruling which they shall show you, to the right hand, nor to the left. [even if per chance they are wrong!]**

12 **And the man that will do arrogantly, and will not listen to the kohen that stands to attend there before יהוה -YHWH your Elohim, or to the shophet, even that man shall die: and you shall put away the evil from Yisrael.**

13 **And all the people shall hear, and fear, and not do arrogantly [against the last legal court of Yisrael].**

We just read your email that you keep the Passover/and the First Day of the Feast Unleavened Bread and the First Day of the Feast of Tabernacles on the full moon. We completely agree with the biblical fact that the First Day of Unleavened Bread and the First Day of the Feast of tabernacle should be kept on the full moon. And the Feast of Trumpets is observed on the new moon. **You stated in your past correspondence that you keep the postponements. If you do keep the postponements, you are not keeping these days on the correct date 40% of the time.**

You said that the Jews have kept these days for the last 1700 years and they have served them well --what does this mean? History reveals that when the Jews returned from captivity, they brought some of the Babylonian influence with them. They (the Jews) were fasting on the Sabbath. When two Sabbaths came together, it was just too much so they adopted the Hillel calendar. Sixty percent of the years since Hillel changed the calendar these days have not been kept on the correct day according to the scriptures and they are not being kept on the full moon. If you keep the postponements, the Feast of Trumpets is always not being kept on the new moon; additionally, if the dates are kept correctly, the Passover/1st Day of Unleavend Bread and the first day of the Feast of tabernacles will always be on the full moon. And if you keep the Feast of Trumpets on the new moon, it will always be correct.

When Yahshua was here on the earth, He kept the days like the scriptures said, and we do not believe the Jews had the authority to create the postponements to start with and did not have the authority to change the days that the scripture said to keep. The scripture does not change nor give anyone the authority to change anything -- all we have is the authority to PRESERVE what was given and keep it.

We study your work every Sabbath and are pleased to see that you are keeping the new moon on the conjunction. We are thrilled to understand, what we believe to be the truth, about the existence of Yahshua and how He came from Yahweh. You are the first person that has been able to give us an understandable explanation of Yahweh and Yahshua, His Son. We could not prove it one way or the other, because Yahshua created everything, but we reasoned to ourselves that maybe Yahweh created Yahshua and then Yahshua created everything.

We would like for you to study into the postponements because we see no reason to believe that ANYONE had the authority make changes.

We call ourselves the Congregation of Yahweh and glad to find someone that has similar beliefs. We look forward to hearing from you.

We have your revised version of the scriptures. We have a lot to learn about the Hebrew language.....we pause your sermons and get the Strong's out. So far we haven't proven you wrong. **(All except the questions on the postponements.)**
